
Care and Maintenance

- Wash periodically by hand with a damp cloth and mild soap
- Use a towel to absorb most of the dampness and then allow to dry at room temperature
- Do not dry clean or tumble dry allow to dry naturally away from direct heat sources
- Do not expose to alcohol, ointments or solvents

Features

- Polypropylene / Polyethylene construction, lined with closed cell foam and secure hook and loop fastening
- Abducts and flexes the hip joint, holding the head of the femur in a stable position
- Provides 90° hip flexion and 60° fixed hip abduction

Fitting Instructions

- Open the Velcro straps on the brace
- Place the patient into the brace and fold over the padded comfort protectors around each leg
- Secure the waist and leg straps
- If necessary, trim the padding with a pair of scissors to alleviate any area that you feel may cause rubbing
