Care and Maintenance

- Wash periodically by hand with a damp cloth and mild soap
- Use a towel to absorb most of the dampness and then allow to dry at room temperature.
- Do not hang up, or iron and do not expose to direct heat sources such as stoves, heaters, radiators, direct sunlight etc
- Do not expose to alcohol, ointments or solvents.



Fitting Instructions

- 1. Hold the collar in both hands so it curves towards the floor
- 2. Hold the vinyl strap in your right hand
- 3. Place the collar underneath you chin and wrap it around your neck
- 4. Fasten the hook and loop strap firmly around the back of your neck ensuring the collar is not too tight to restrict breathing or circulation

Adjusting your Collar

- The depth of the collar can be adjusted by separating the two sections and re positioning them
- 2. The collar should fit snugly between your collar bone and chin
